I am very pleased with the results of my new lawn. I believe that the mixture you applied to it helped a great deal. It seems to be doing very well for this time of year. I expected it to be more yellow than it is after the winter. My neighbor planted lawn seed around the same time that I did and hers is almost completely yellow, while mine is more than half green. I was pleased to note that there were no ill effects on any of the surrounding vegetation (rose bushes, trees, ivy & other plants that were newly planted). It clearly is safer to use as a fertilizer for "new" lawns and in areas where there are other plants that could have been damaged by other lawn fertilizers. Also, my cats did not get sick or suffer any ill effects from it. Try as I might, I could not keep them off the new lawn. Not only did the lawn grow in lush and green, it seems to be more established than it would have been without the application of your "fertilizer". I would definitely use it in the future. I sincerely hope that you are able to produce and market this product in the near future. I would buy it and feel better about using it than the conventional fertilizers on the market.
